 Saturday, February 27, 2010 – 10:00 am – 12:00 pm

All new and returning players must sign up and register at one of the above dates to be eligible to play. New players and players who have not previously shown birth certificates must show a **CERTIFIED birth certificate** at the time of registration in order to play.

LEAGUE ORGANIZATIONS

PLAYERS 8-12 YEARS OLD

LONGMEADOW TRAVEL BASEBALL 5/1/97-4/30/02 -- 8-12 years old

Tryouts Saturday, **March 13th at Greenwood Park, time schedule to be determined.**
All returning players and new players pre-selected in the fall, 2009, need not attend tryouts.

All returning and newly selected players regardless of age will participate in a pre-season **Instructional “Camp” which will begin on March 15 at 4 p.m. at Greenwood Park.**

Teams play at the highest level of 8-12 competition and will represent Longmeadow in a suburban baseball league such as the Tri-Town league or the Springfield John L. Sullivan League. If interested, players who have not played in the travel league must register prior to evaluations and attend the evaluation on March 13th. Any player not selected for the **travel league** will be allowed to play in Little League.

All 8-9 year olds and some 10 year olds will play on a travel team using a 60-Foot diamond. The remaining 10 year olds and 11-12 year olds will play on travel teams using a 75 foot diamond.

The 11-12 year olds and some 10 year olds will play on a 75 foot diamond. This league also uses the **Official Rules of Baseball:** pitchers hold runners on base, runners take leads and steal. Depending on player availability, teams may participate in regional post-season tournaments.

The Travel baseball program will field teams that will compete in skill appropriate divisions with 2-3 games per week plus practices. Each team will be limited to 12/14 players. Travel is modest as teams participating are from local towns and half of the games should be in Longmeadow. Carpooling for travel games is available. The regular schedule (approximately 20 games) leads to a league tournament for each team. The philosophy of the league is to try to balance the teams so that each player can be a contributing member of the team. Each player is issued a complete uniform. Games may be scheduled any day of the week. Parents are strongly encouraged to participate and develop their instructional and coaching skills as a head or assistant coach. **Players participating on baseball teams in other towns are not eligible to play in these leagues.**

PLAYERS 13-19 YEARS OLD

LONGMEADOW INTERMEDIATE TRAVEL 13-14

All players must attend a two week instructional **camp** which will begin on **April 5, 2010** time and location determined. At the conclusion of the camp, players will be placed on either a **Tri-Town Pony** team or **Sandy Koufax**. Each player is issued a complete uniform, travel is required.

TRI TOWN PONY LEAGUE 5/1/95-4/30/97

This league provides players who would normally be playing at the Babe Ruth level the opportunity to play at a more competitive level in a travel program and represent Longmeadow in this league. Travel is modest as teams participating are from local towns and half of the games should be in Longmeadow. Carpooling for travel games is available. The season runs from early May through the end of June, with some post season play possible.

SANDY KOUFAX 5/1/95-4/30/97

Teams play at a higher level of competition and represent Longmeadow in a Sandy Koufax league for 13-14 year olds. **The regular season will last from about the middle of May through the middle of July.** Post-season tournament play may also be available. All players **should be available** for that time period, although limited vacation time may be acceptable. 14 year olds in high school may play either Sandy Koufax or Mickey Mantle at the discretion of the coaches.

MICKEY MANTLE 5/1/93-4/30/96

Teams play at a higher level of competition and represent Longmeadow in the NEYSA Mickey Mantle league. This league is for 14-16 year olds (in high school). Teams will be decided after the regular High School season. **The regular season will last from about June 1 through the middle of July.** All players **should be available** for that time period, although limited vacation time may be acceptable. Post-season tournament play may also be available. Travel is required. Each player will be issued a uniform. Since slots are limited all players must be registered before the scheduled tryouts and must attend at least one tryout to be eligible to be placed on a team. Tryouts will be announced for sometime in May. Players not selected will have their fees refunded.

AMERICAN LEGION 1/1/91-7/31/93

This league is a highly competitive, varsity level program for 17-19 year olds in high school or college. **Players will be selected through tryouts. Notification of the tryout schedule will be made through local newspapers and posted at Longmeadow High School.** Should there be enough players a different 17-19 team will be attempted as well. **The Legion season runs from mid-June (after High School playoffs) until mid-July.** It is about one month long with 18-20 games, including one possible out of town tournament. Each player will be issued a uniform. **Players must make a commitment to be available for the one month season.**
